<u>Carnaval</u>

Friday, February 23rd 2024, in collaboration with our Grade 7 & 8s, Chris Hadfield Public School will be hosting Carnaval for all of our students (Kindergarten to Grade 6). We will be having a day of Winter Carnaval activities similar to those celebrated in Quebec during Winter Carnaval. Our students will have the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of activities as a whole school community such as snow soccer, snow painting, etc.

We ask that everyone dress for the weather and **wear appropriate clothing such as snow pants**, **boots, coats, hats and mitts** for the day as needed.

Field Trips

Please make sure you are accessing School Cash On-line to pay for your students' field trips/school events as soon as you are able. We do our best to post the events early so that families have as much time as possible to make these payments. Without the minimum being paid, fieldtrips may have to be canceled. Thank you for your support and cooperation.

Parking Lot

During morning drop off (9:00 a.m. – 9:15 a.m.), for students who are being dropped off in the kiss and ride area, we are asking drivers to please <u>drive slowly</u> and <u>wait patiently</u> until a spot along the sidewalk becomes available for a safe drop off. When possible, move as far up along the sidewalk as space allows. If at all possible, students should exit the vehicle from the LEFT hand side, closest to the gate entrance. *Cars should not be left unattended or idling, nor should they be parked in the middle of the kiss and ride to drop off students.* If you would prefer to wait and watch your child enter the building, please park your car in the lot and walk them to the gate. *Please do not park in the kiss and ride lanes.*

Our parking lot will be closed from 3:20 p.m. until 3:45 p.m. During this 25 minute time period, cars will be unable to enter or leave the parking lot. This is to reduce traffic and to help ensure the safety of nearly 700 students being dismissed at the end of the school day. *Please do not pull into or park in the lot if you need to leave before 3:45 pm*. By parking on a nearby side street, and walking students to and from that spot you may actually save time by avoiding congested traffic areas. Please be mindful of your speed when driving through our parking lot.
